

## Course aims

1. Introduce basic narrative ideas and thoughts;
2. Invite participants to reflect on the impact of dominant culture on their lives and those who consult them;
3. Share with participants the opportunities to put narrative thoughts and skills into practice.

2. Practise narrative ideas and reflect on self in the meaning making process.
