

Narrative Therapy Interviewing: Re-authoring and Re-working Reputations

4 - 5 December, 2018

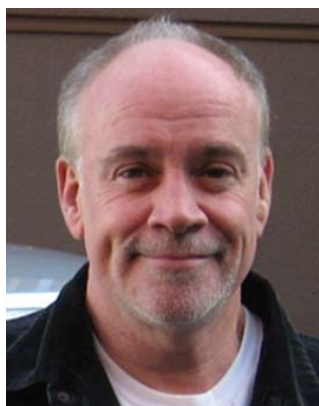
The practice of re-authoring and re-working client reputations is central to narrative therapy interviewing. Dr. Madigan's new and unique workshop examines and explains 3 narrative therapy sessions conducted by 3 different narrative therapists – all working with the same problem. The session tapes of **David Epston (1992)**, **Michael White (1996)** and **his own work (2016)** are critically analyzed for their similarities and differences in their practice purpose to re-author and re-work reputations with persons' lives and relationships.

The workshop offers participants a close up breakdown of narrative therapy practice and discusses the thinking and intentions behind each therapist's questions that each of the three therapists find useful.

Participants will learn to ask narrative questions that:

- ◆ Offer options to assist the telling and re-telling of preferred stories and values of people's lives and relationships
- ◆ Make visible the unique, the contradictory, and the important events of people's lives significant as alternative possibilities
- ◆ Re-engage client histories through alternative re-tellings and re-remembering of people's lives and a re-engagement that brings these alternative re-tellings together with past relevant experiences
- ◆ Explore alternative knowledges, values, abilities and skills that inform these new expressions, and to identify the cultural history and location of these abilities, skills, values and knowledges

Dr. Madigan is an award winning couple and family therapist and best selling author of Narrative Therapy – theory and practice. He is the Director of the Vancouver School for Narrative Therapy, TCTV.live, and consultant supervisor of Norway's National Couple Conflict Team. During 2017, Stephen taught narrative therapy workshops on a variety of different therapeutic issues on 5 different continents. His newest book on Narrative Therapy is published by the American Psychological Association and coming out in February 2019.
